



Acadiana Amateur Radio Association Field Day – June 24-25, 2023

For 2023, the AARA will be hosting Field Day at the farm of Steve and Mel Webre. We are looking forward to this event and we hope that you can spend some time with us. Handicap parking is available and bathroom amenities are on premises. We will begin setting stations up Saturday morning at 0800, with Field Day officially starting at 1300 and running until 1300 on Sunday. We will be using the call W5DDL and operating class will be determined once we get a count of the number of stations operating.

LOCATION: 1529 Beaugh St., Church Point, LA (Google Maps Directions) Directions from I-10 (Rayne/Church Point Exit)

1. Take LA 35 north into Church Point.
2. Turn Left onto S. Main St. (Sonic Drive In on corner)
3. Turn Right onto E Plaquemine St. (Daigle Hardware on corner)
4. Travel approximately 1/3 mile and turn Left onto N. Beaugh St. (Local Bar on corner)
5. Travel 1 mile and AF5VR's driveway will be on the left.

Please use caution when entering as folks will be setting up their stations.

Please remain on gravel drive unless directed otherwise

CAMPING:

Please help by adhering to band allocations that will be posted. If you want to operate on a "band in use" accommodations can be made to get you in an area that avoids interference. Please coordinate with the operating station.
